

The CRP land, which was enrolled in October 2021 and is set to expire in September 2031, offers an annual rental income of \$11,591, or \$143.85 per acre. This area is planted with a combination of cool and warm-season grasses, creating ideal bedding and habitat for local wildlife, making it a dream for hunters and nature enthusiasts alike.

Speaking of hunting, this farm has everything you need to pursue your favorite game. The varied landscape, with its natural drainages and rolling hills, provides perfect travel corridors for Whitetail deer. Whether you're into archery or rifle hunting, you'll find plenty of opportunities to stalk game. There's even evidence of turkeys in the area, with tracks spotted and sightings reported during the property's inspection. For those who are passionate about turkey hunting, a few prescribed burns ahead of the season could make this a prime location. And if you're into waterfowl, keep an eye on the lake where Swans have been spotted, adding the possibility of seasonal waterfowl hunting opportunities.
