Most parcels > 10 ac labeled

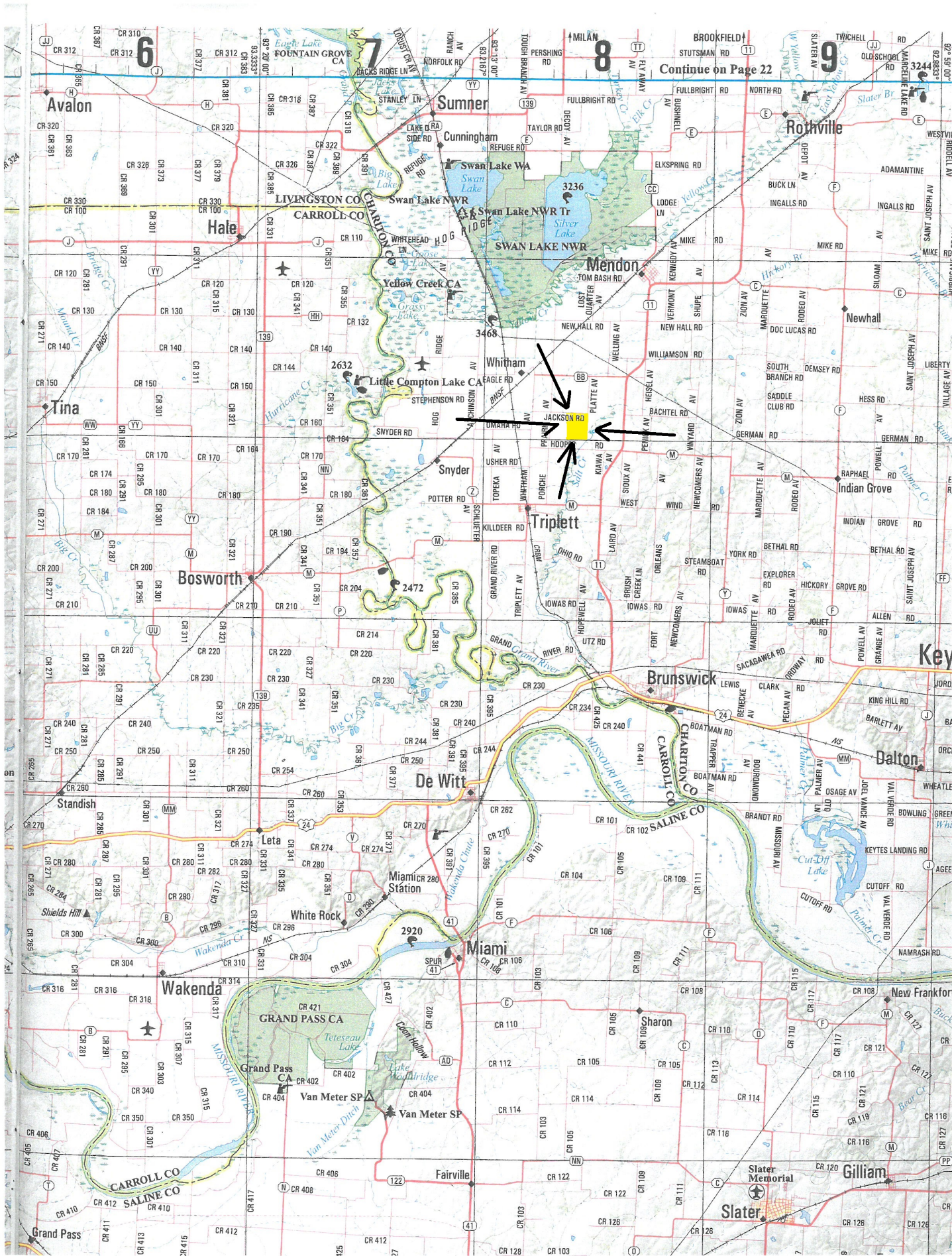
