DESCRIPTION: Located in Macon County, the NITZSCHE LEGACY TRUST is a true sportsman's paradise providing year-round enjoyment for the avid outdoorsman. The 171 acres is not only home to incredible deer and turkey hunting, it also offers excellent angling opportunities. It is an appealing waterfowl location and lies in close proximity to additional outdoor attractions such as Thomas Hill Reservoir which is known for it's excellent all-around fishing (crappie & hybrid bass and boating recreation. This land is surrounded by many public waterfowl, big game, and dove and upland hunting opportunities.
